

Purpose

This seminar aims to equip employees with essential knowledge of tax laws and regulations, highlighting tax-saving opportunities and schemes to reduce the company's tax liability. It covers strategies to avoid errors and penalties, ensuring accurate reporting and financial stability, and emphasizes efficient handling of tax tasks to improve operational efficiency. The seminar also focuses on staying updated with tax law changes and understanding the tax implications of business decisions to make informed choices that benefit the company's financial health and sustainability.

Training Objectives

The seminar goals is to provide a comprehensive understanding of the Cyprus tax system, including taxpayer obligations and regulatory frameworks. It covers the calculation and implications of the special contribution for defence (SCD), capital gains tax, and valueadded tax (VAT) for both individuals and companies. Participants will learn to evaluate and compute income and corporation tax liabilities, understand the impact of social insurance contributions, and develop employability and technology skills relevant to tax compliance and analysis. The seminar emphasizes practical application through the use of software tools to navigate and comply with the Cyprus tax system effectively.

Methodology

The seminar will take place using the method of live online laearning through the Zoom platform. During the seminar, various interactive techniques will be used, such as lecture, presentation, questions - answers, discussion, group work, practical exercises.



The program has been approved by the Human Resource Development Authority (HRDA). Businesses/organizations that participate in it with their employees, as well as unemployed individuals, will receive the relevant subsidy, provided that they meet the HRDA's requirements.
