



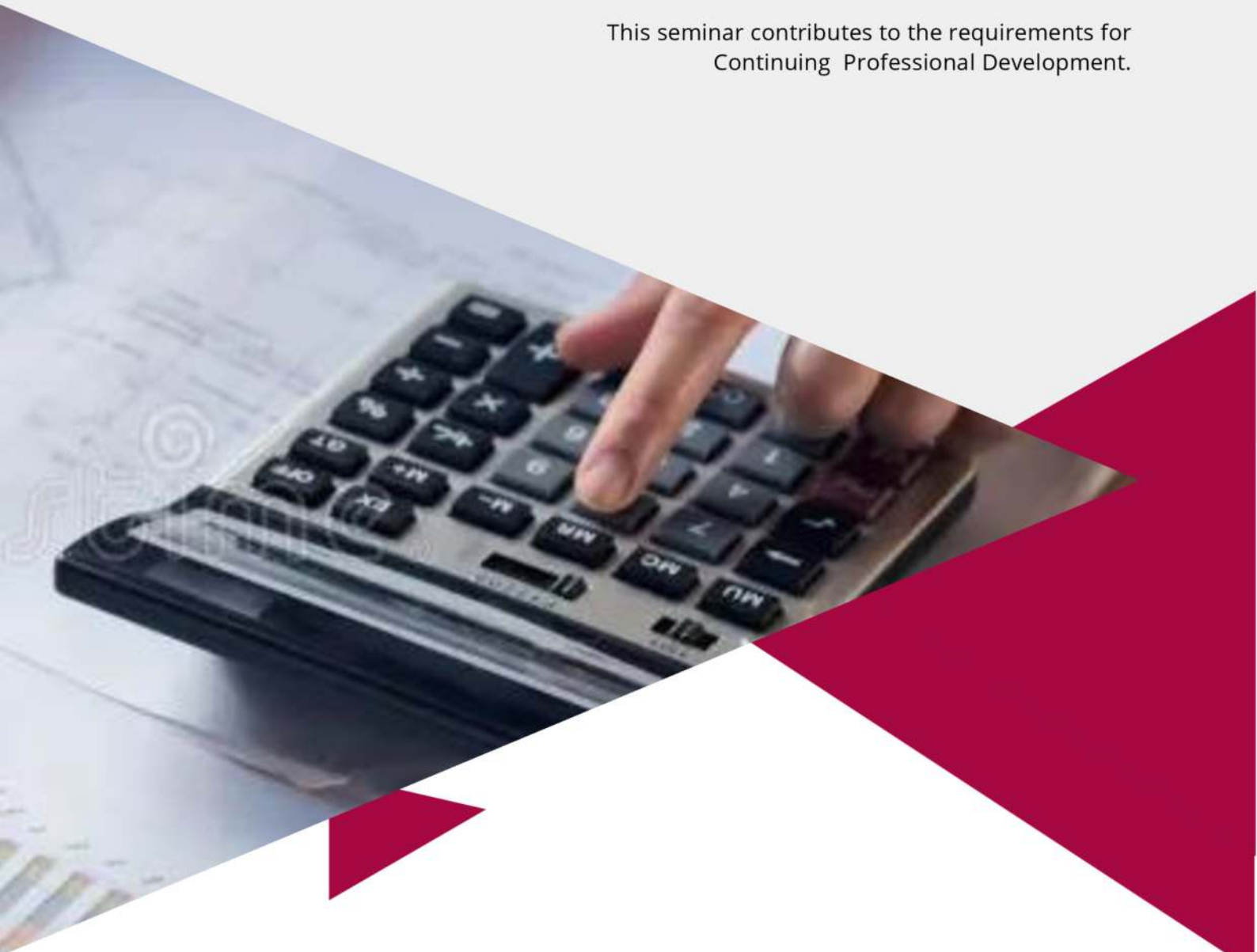

Seminar Overview
