Purpose

Training Objectives

Methodology

The seminar will take place using the method of live online learning through the Microsoft Teams platform. During the seminar, various interactive techniques will be used, such as lecture, presentation, questions - answers, discussion, group work, practical exercises.

This seminar is intended for a wide range of professionals engaged in audit, assurance, risk management, and compliance across both the public and private sectors. Ideal candidates include external and internal auditors, accountants, compliance officers, risk management professionals, financial controllers, and staff from regulatory bodies and oversight authorities. It is particularly suitable for professionals who already possess a working knowledge of audit and assurance practices and are seeking to deepen their expertise, broaden the scope of services offered, and stay updated with recent developments and expectations in the profession.
